



Adventure worlds in the Papiliorama

In addition to the butterfly dome which is home to over 1,000 species of exotic butterflies, there is the Nocturama, where nocturnal animals from the Amazon can be observed during the day. In the Tropendom Jungle Trek you can then take an exciting hike through the tropical forest.



Witch path Schwarzsee

This adventure trail takes you around the idyllic landscape of the Schwarzsee (black lake) with a detour to a spectacular waterfall. On the lovingly designed route, guests can immerse themselves into a world of mythical creatures, forest animals and the magic interaction between man and nature. Experience seven fairy tales in a fun and enchanting way.



Elf and gnome path Wolfwil

Along the 3.5 km long exploration path in the magical Wolfwil forest, hand-painted, wooden games await children at 20 interactive stations. There are various puzzles, skill games, riddles and various gnome and elf dwellings where kids can enter.



Water Park Bernaqua

Whether it's whizzing down an aquatic slide on an over-sized inflatable, floating down the lazy river, jumping into ice-cold water, having a water fight on a pirate ship or relaxing in the wellness area; the water park Bernaqua has something to offer for the whole family.



Natural History Museum Bern

Thanks to its historical exhibitions of domestic and exotic animals, this museum is unique in Europe and enjoys an excellent international reputation. One of the most famous objects is the world-famous rescue dog Barry. Another highlight are the impressive giant crystals from the Planggenstock mountains.

Bern Animal Park – Dählhölzli

The Bern Zoo is beautifully situated directly on the Aare River and nestled in the Dählhölzli forest. Most of the animals (over 200 exotic and Nordic-European species) live in the park with a tropical vivarium and spacious outdoor areas. Some native species on the banks of the Aare as well as the children's zoo are freely accessible.



Kambly Experience

Dive into the world of Kambly at the centre of the idyllic Emmental Valley and discover the secrets of the art of fine biscuit making, for a mouth-watering sensory experience. During the confectionery master-class, visitors also have the opportunity to look over the shoulders of the master confectioners and then taste the over 100 varieties of biscuit.



Rope Park Bern

The rope park is located in the middle of the Dählhölzli forest and offers 10 different courses, including 3 especially for children. With its suspension bridges, ropeways and over 120 platforms, the park is one of the largest in Switzerland.



BearPark, Tierpark Bern

Located at the end of Bern's old town, the BearPark offers visitors the opportunity to meet bears in a species-appropriate environment. On freely accessible visitor paths leading around the grounds, the bears can also be observed from close up as they play, eat, climb and swim.



Gurten – Park in the Green

The so-called local mountain of Bern is an absolute paradise for children and offers a fantastic view over the city and the Bernese Alps. A toboggan run, a disc golf course, a miniature railway, a large playground with a play kite and various biking and hiking trails all contribute to an memorable family day out.



Bimano kids

The 850 m2 indoor playground offers a wide variety of attractions for children. Designed as an exercise park or adventure playground, children can discover, among other things, a ball pool in the great white shark, a volcano for climbing and sliding, two high-reaching rope tunnels and many other attractions.



Museum of Communication

Try it out and join in - the museum with its many interconnected stations, large video screens and unexpected objects has so much on offer for children and adults alike. Discover the development of telecommunication in a fun and playful way.



Sensorium in Rütthubelbad

The exhibition is a complete sensory experience, where everything revolves around the stimulation of sensory perceptions. Visitors of all ages are invited to try things out and observe at 80 interactive stations. Sounds, colours, vibrations, scents, light and darkness arouse amazement and allow visitors to explore the laws of nature.



Creaviva

The children's museum enables diverse and entertaining access to art and culture. The aim is that kids, young people, and adults become creative themselves and live out artistic fantasies. Various studios and workshops are waiting to be discovered.



Swiss open-air museum Ballenberg

Experience Swiss traditions: In this open-air museum you can discover more than 100 historical buildings from all over Switzerland, over 200 native farm animals and demonstrations of traditional craft-making. The little ones will certainly not be bored either, because there is always something going on in the pastures, petting enclosure and stables. Furthermore, there is a carousel, a large playground and many traditional children's toys.
